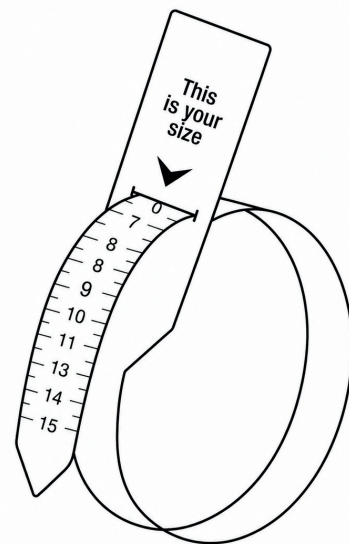


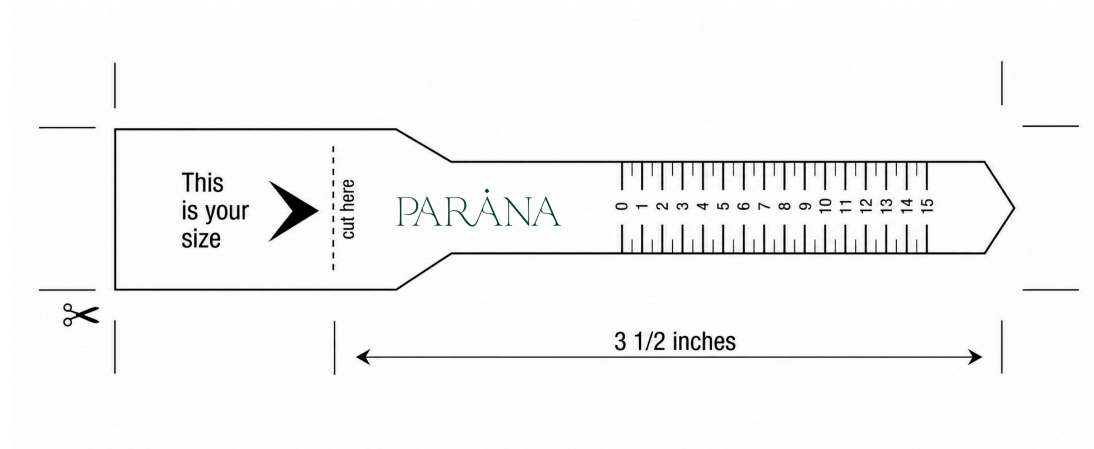
1. Print this page at 100% scale using Letter-size paper. Do not select "Fit to Page" or any scaling option.
2. Carefully cut out the ring sizer following the outline. Then cut the small slit marked on the band.
3. Insert the pointed end through the slit to create an adjustable loop, keeping the size markings facing outward.
4. Slide the ring sizer onto the finger where the ring will be worn and gently tighten it until it fits comfortably—snug, but not tight.
5. Read the size indicated by the edge of the slit. This number is your recommended ring size.

Tip: If your measurement falls between two sizes, we recommend choosing the larger size for a more comfortable fit.



In the example shown here, the ring size is **6**.

HANDS ON!



INSTRUCTIONS:

- To obtain an accurate ring size measurement, **page scaling must be set to “100%” in your print dialog box.**
- Make sure to uncheck all **“scale to fit”** checkboxes when printing.

Using a ring worn on the same finger you want sized, place the ring on a circle below. The circle should fit snugly on the inside of the ring. The estimated size appears inside the circle.

Tip: If your measurement falls between two sizes, we recommend choosing the larger size for a more comfortable fit.
